# COMMON REQUIREMENTS

The task of the contest is comprised of two themes. To participate, you must send 3 or more designs for each of the contest themes. Overall, the minimum number of works should amount to 6.

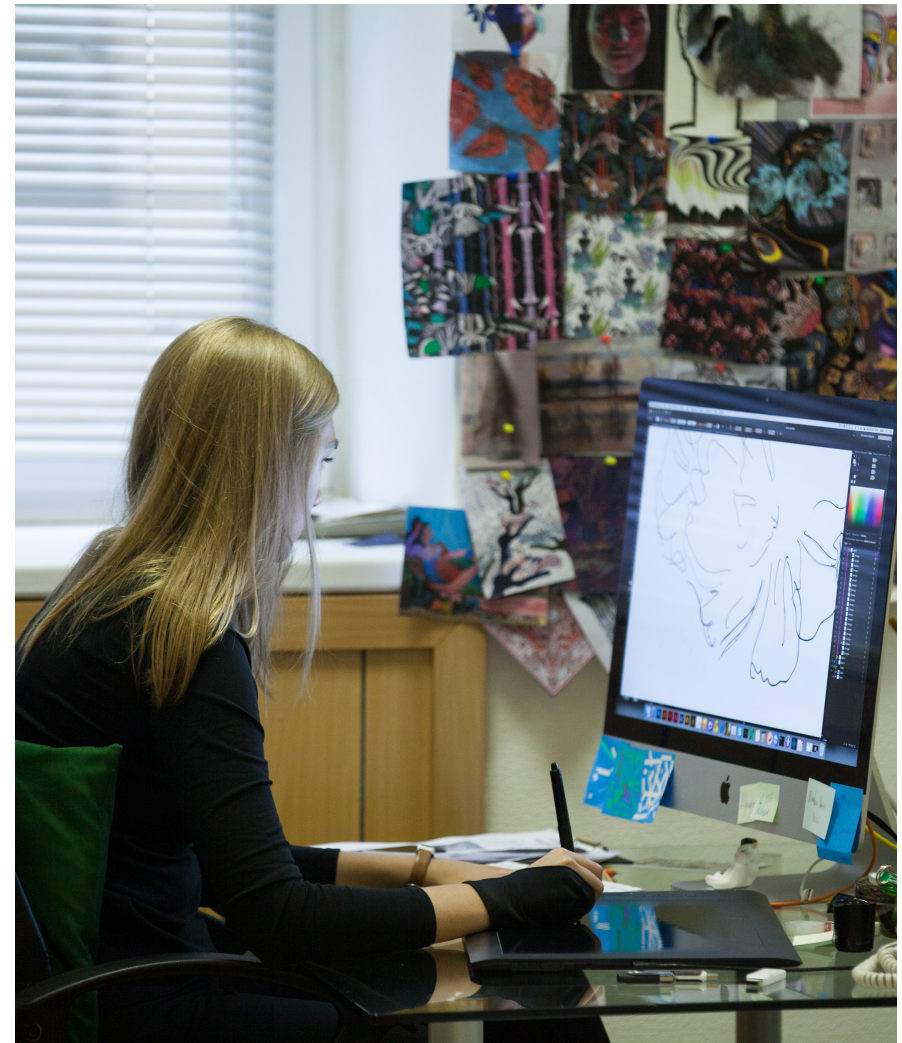
The works of each participant are assessed as a whole. The themes of the contest are presented as mood boards.

Mood boards are not a direct guideline to follow – you should not try to repeat the works presented in them. The contestant can freely interpret the materials presented for inspiration, in accordance with their own vision.

The submitted work may be a composition with or without repeats. You may submit new works created specifically for this contest or designs you have made before. We urge you to be attentive to copyright compliance!

Artificial intelligence can be used as an auxiliary tool to create a composition, to search for unusual details and color combinations. Works created entirely by AI will not be accepted.

Technical requirements: JPEG format, image size: not to exceed 1 MB, not less than 1,000 pixels on the longitudinal side, resolution: 150 dpi.

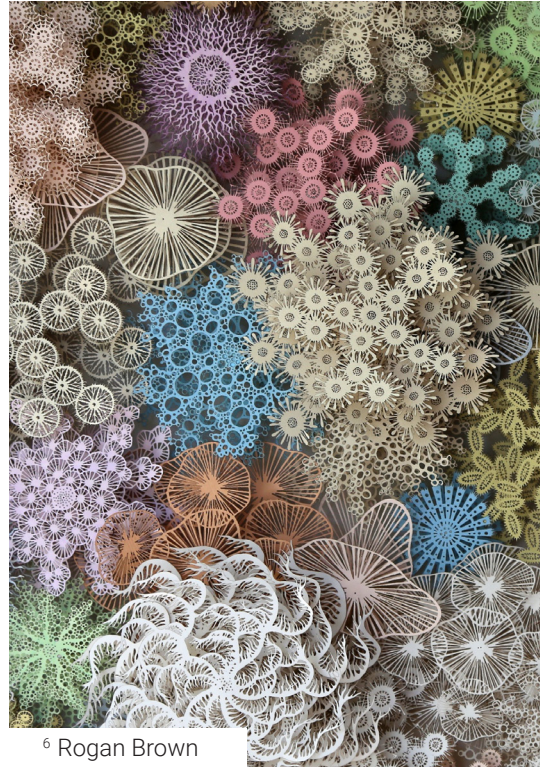

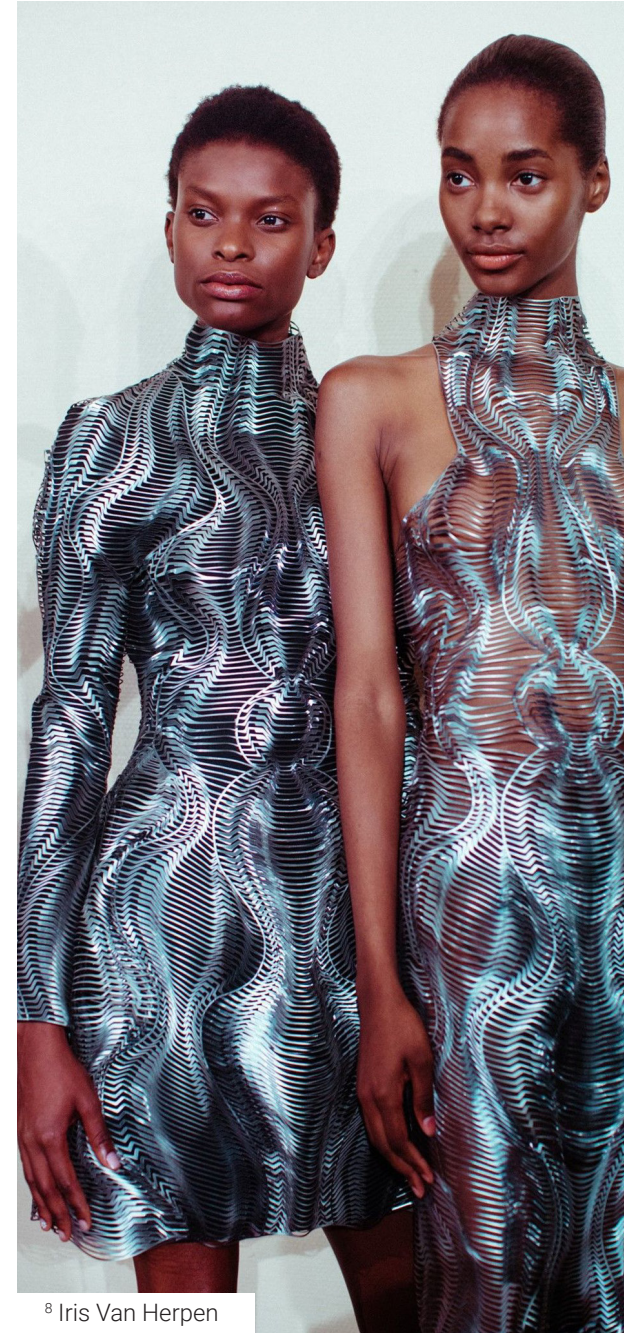

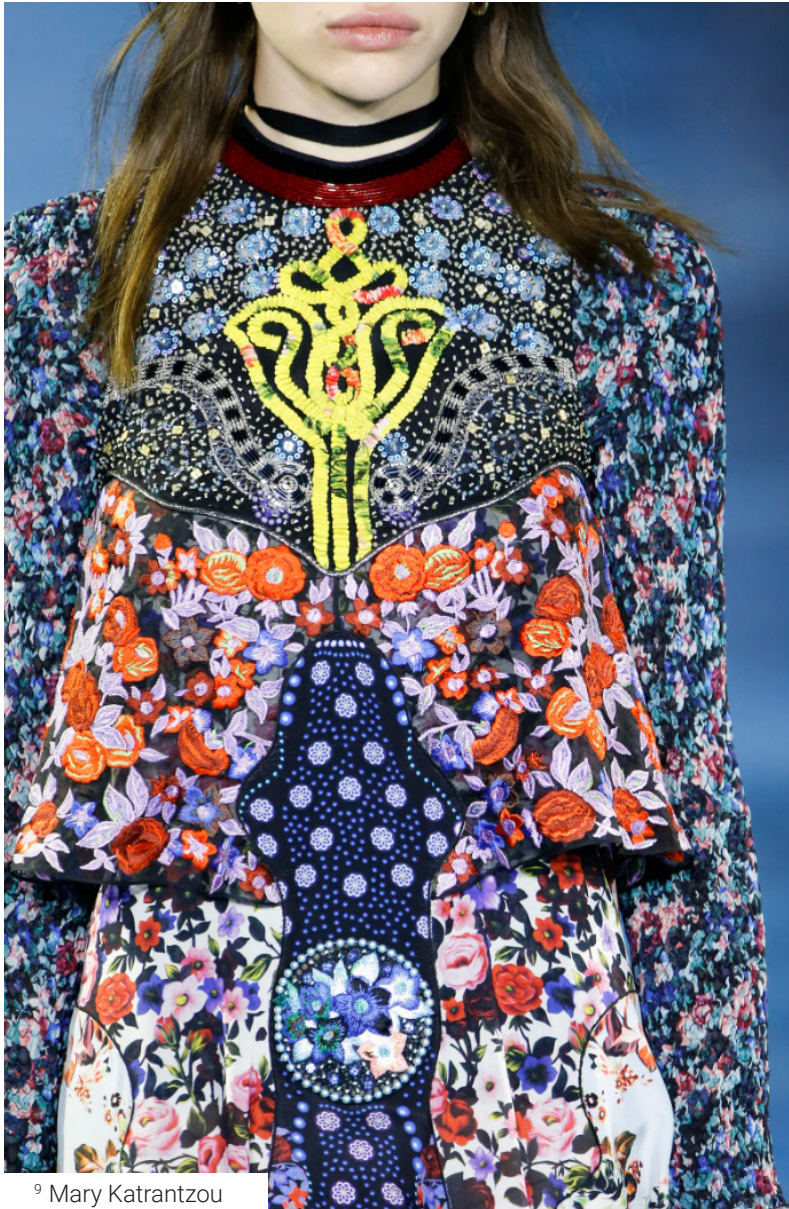
